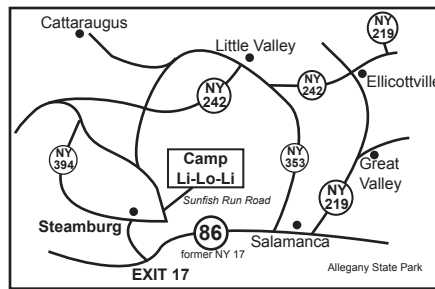

Camp Li-Lo-Li is located in Western New York near the Pennsylvania border and Allegany State Park, about halfway between Erie, PA and Buffalo, NY.

Traveling on Interstate 86 (formerly Route 17), get off at exit 17. Go to the stop sign at Steamburg and turn right. Turn right onto Sunfish Run Road just past the underpass. Follow this road 6 miles into Camp Li-Lo-Li.

It is recommended that you DO NOT use internet "mapquest" type directions. They take you to a road that is CLOSED, and cannot access the camp.
